


OUR CONCERN?

To meet the needs of **658 families** in the ongoing financial year, **Al-Mavineen** needs a total sum of **Rs. 200 lakh**. However, we have only been able to generate **Rs. 150 lakh** till date, and the routine collection would amount to a maximum of **Rs. 160 lakh**. Therefore, we are faced with an acute shortage of funds to help those who need it the most. It is urgent to generate **Rs. 40 lakh** to **meet** the needs of the **poor** and **needy** in the **current financial year.**

COST OF THE PANDEMIC!

Covid-19 has pushed 143 million to poverty and 163 million people to extreme poverty in the world. Our society has also seen a rise in people facing economic stress under prevailing circumstances.

At the local level in **Baramulla** town, **Idarah Falahudarain** had only **415** economically distressed families to **support** in **2018–19**, but **Covid–19** and other factors increased this number by **60%**, making it **658**.
