As a leading charity organization in Baramulla town, Al-Mavineen has been offering financial support to more than 650 families on regular basis. Making best use of your charitable contributions, we have been supporting the widows, orphans, economically weaker sections, and people in educational and medical needs for over two decades. Your donations have created hope in the lives of hopeless, and they are continuously being empowered through assistance to their livelihood, education, healthcare and other needs. In the last two decades, you have contributed in crores towards this cause, and every penny is making a difference. In the last year, Al-Mavineen has spent around 1.8 crore rupees to assist the needy. Around 1 crore rupees were spent on aiding the poor, 40 lac on helping orphans, widows and divorcees, 40 lac on medical aid, educational support and micro financing of the skilled needy families. In the Covid-19 pandemic days, the donations you made helped in the survival of more than 700 people. We reached out to the people in need of oxygen, food and assistance. Many of you have participated in our blood donation camps and medical awareness camps. We have adopted modern technology to make our system efficient and transparent. The beneficiaries get direct bank transfer into their accounts. The records are clean and clear.

The Charity Potential of Baramulla Town

Memories allow us a time travel into the history. Ask the Founders of Falahudarain, they would reveal that the first year collection of the donation for the social work was less than Rs. 50000.00. In 2022-23, the peoples contribution to support poor and needy increased to Rs. 1.8 crore. This journey from a few Thousand to 180 Lac Rupees reflects the charitable sense of the residents of the town and their trust on Falahudarain. In the journey of two decades, it has emerged that Baramulla town has more than 600 families who live in poverty and need assistance for basic amenities like livelihood, education and healthcare. With 2 crore donation for 650+ families, the average donation received by a family is less than Rs. 2500.00. No family can thrive on this meagre amount.

Where is the solution? Can a charitable organisation make a significant change in the lives of the poor and needy? The question merits a response.

The answer lies in untapping the potential of Zakat and other charities in the town. The moot point is that the Baramulla town is donating far less than its potential. Here is how?

Take the lower side that the Baramulla town has a population of 1.5 lac Muslims with a family size of 8 members, meaning 18750 families. Assume only 10% of these families (1870 families) have to pay Zakat and average Zakat donation is Rs. 50000 for a family annually. The total Zakat collection would exceed 9 Crore Rupees.

Of that, assume that 50% of the population are women, and only 4% of them (3000 women) own the gold with valuation more than the *NISAAB* (min. amount required that makes a person liable for paying the Zakaat), and each of these woman pays just 10000 in Zakat. This amounts to 3 crore rupees as Zakaat donation.

It has been observed that Zakat constitutes 60% of donations made by Muslims and other donations are Sadqa, Kafarah, Fidya etc. This amounts to another 4 crore rupees. Baramulla town has a potential to generate around 10-15 Crore rupees in charity. This amount, if donated, collected and used in an organized manner can end the poverty in the town.

We utilize online platforms and technology to ensure that donations go directly to those in need without any intermediary involvement, providing greater efficiency and transparency in our operations.






TWO DECADES OF CHANGE AND TRANSFORMATION

FEW STORIES

"CHARITY TRANSFORMS SOCIETY"

I am Zaid (name changed), a resident of old town of Baramulla. We are two brothers born in an economically weak family. It was hard for our father to make both the ends meet. The family discourse was to make us earn sooner than later, but we wanted education before making the money. With limited resources in hand, it was hard for our family to support our education. Our zeal for learning was well known and so was our financial condition. One fine day, at the sun set, a young man gave our father a glad tiding that the education of his wards shall be sponsored by Al-Mavineen, the Charity Department of Falahudarain. Our hopes as if reborn, and we got a new life. We were helped for our educational expenses and other basic needs for many years. Today, both of us have Degrees from University of Kashmir and joined the government jobs. I cracked a prestigious exam and today my salary is 15 times more than what my father earned. Thanks to Falahudarian and its donors who shaped our future and built our careers.

I am Mustaqeem (Name changed) and my story is a tragic one. I was doing well and earning good to sustain my family. I had a wife and four children. I worked as a driver for a vehicle carrying mined rocks from our vicinity. One fateful day, when we were loading the tipper, a heavy rock fell on my head, and I was grievously injured. I was operated in the hospital but I lost the eye sight and was paralyzed. I lost all the hope that day. Initially, I received the help from vehicle owner but he was unable to sustain my family for long. After he gave up, it was as if my wife and the children were to beg to survive. Then came, Al-Mavineen - the Charity Department of Idarah Falahudarain, and it has been providing me with financial support for more than a decade now. It not only sustained my family for basic needs, it made sure that my children go to school and educate themselves. Two of my children graduated from Kashmir University recently, and the other two are in their schooling days. I have been assured that my family will be supported till my children begin to earn and feed us. I fear if there are no organisations like this, who will take care of the destitute like me?

I am Davood (Name changed) and I own a business today. Eight years back, I was working at an auto mechanic shop for just Rs. 4000.00. My ailing mother had far more expenses than I earned. The overall family condition was worsening day after day. Al-Mavineen started assisting our family. One day, they approached me and pointed towards my skill of repairing the car wheels. I was told that I would be financed for creating my own business venture and I had to dedicate myself to my work. I agreed to the terms and conditions. Today, I not only earn my own livelihood and support my family; I am able to create jobs for others. Once I was receiving charity, today I am in a position to make charity. Thanks to micro financing policy of Al-Mavineen, IFD for creating a business man out of me.

Identification of the Needy

Al-Mavineen has appointed coordinators (called Mohalla Zimedaar) for different areas of Baramulla. The coordinator identifies the needy in the locality. People, sometimes, refer the names of the needy persons to the coordinator.

Verification of the Needy



The coordinator, after identification, collects detailed information about the person. His/her sources of income, expenditure, needs and other relevant details are collected. A decision is made after thorough investigation of facts available on the ground. Once found deserving, the name is referred for financial help, as per the need of the person. A prescribed form is submitted online containing the details of the needy and a recommendation in his/her favour for financial support. Verification of every beneficiary is repeated every month to ascertain existing status of need.

Approval of financial support



The Secretary of Al-Mavineen - the Charity Department of Idarah Falahudarain, takes the facts into consideration and decides the amount of financial support. He issues directions for Direct Bank to Bank transfer of amount from Al-Mavineen account into the account of beneficiaries. The records are maintained for income and expenditure.
